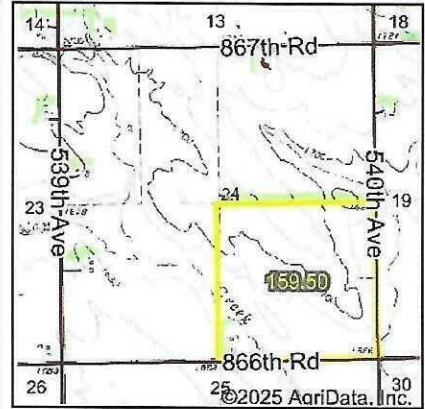

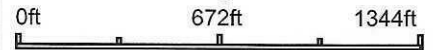

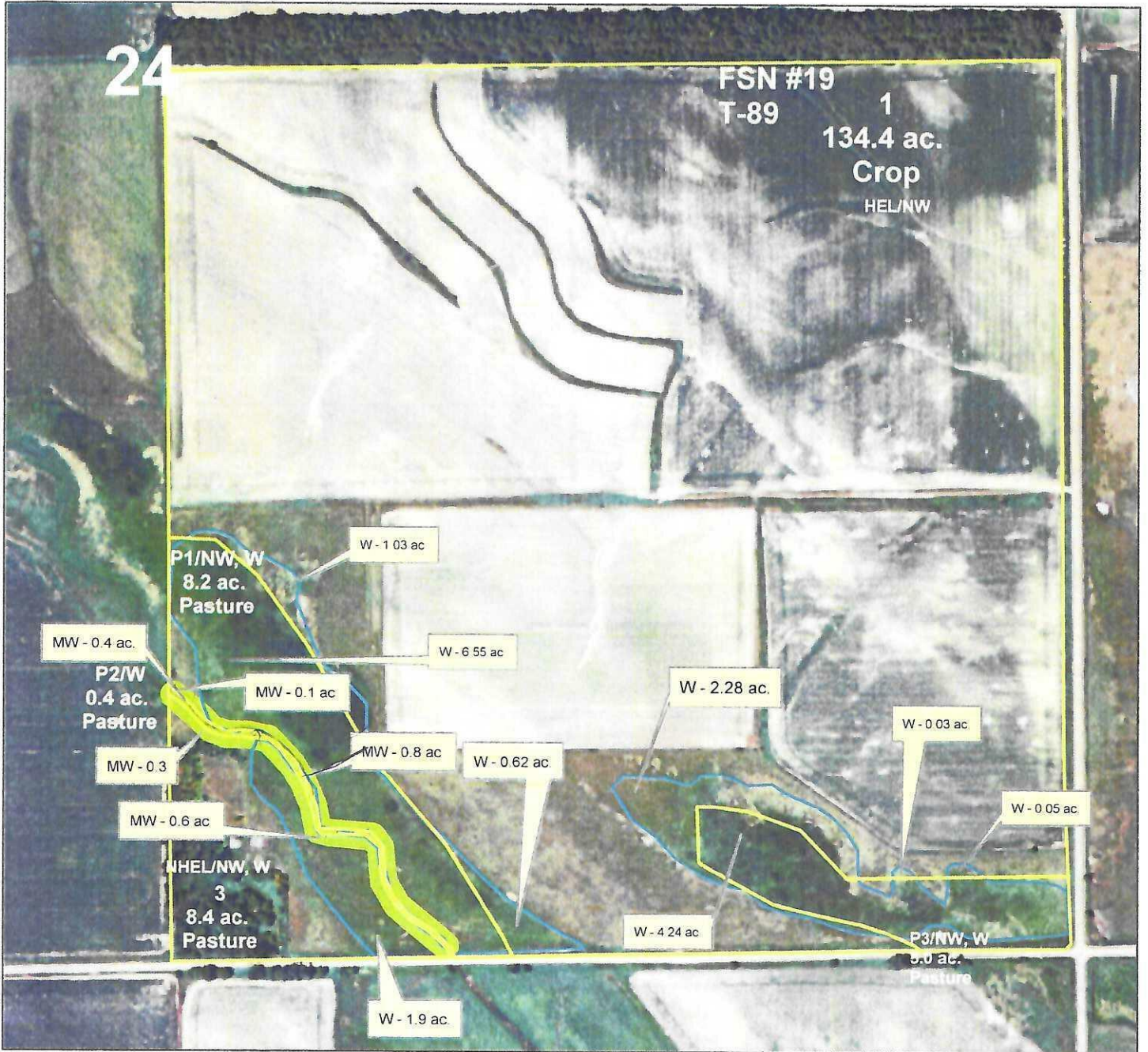
MINIMAL EFFECT MAP
